MESSAGE FROM FPL: Investing in the electrical infrastructure in your area.

A project to upgrade the electric system in your area will begin soon. It's part of our commitment to improve your service by reducing power interruptions.

An FPL-approved contractor, F & H Contractors, will upgrade sections of the underground power line in your neighborhood Laurel Landings Estates. Work is scheduled to begin on June 02, 2016 and is expected to be completed by July 01, 2016.

This proactive maintenance work does not require a power outage. However, if we find that an interruption is needed to complete the work safely, we'll notify you in advance. You can be sure we'll do everything possible to keep the length of any outage to a minimum.

Before starting this project, we will mark the locations of other underground utilities such as water, gas, sewer and communication lines to ensure safety. We'll mark only the streets and sidewalks where the underground work is needed. If any digging is required on your property, we promise to restore the area once our work is completed.
